In addition to the items listed in my earlier email, please address the following discrepancy regarding your operational altitude:

The Form 442 currently requests 8000 feet AGL for Air-to-Ground operations. However, the AFTRCC coordination you provided authorizes a maximum flight altitude of 2500 feet AGL.

Please take one of the following actions:

1. Update Form 442 to reflect a maximum altitude of 2500 feet AGL,
OR
2.
Provide a revised AFTRCC coordination letter that authorizes 8000 feet AGL.

Additionally, please ensure that the following parameters are identical between the AFTRCC coordination and the Form 442 submission:

- a. Geographical coordinates
- b. Area of operation
- c. Emission designators and power levels
- d. Maximum altitude

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of May 20, 2026 may result in application dismissal pursuant to 47 CFR § 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to 47 CFR § 1.1111.
