Dear Ms. Dortch:

Aireon LLC ("Aireon"), a wholly owned subsidiary of Aireon Holdings LLC ("Aireon Holdings"), supplements the above-referenced application to provide updated information regarding Aireon's ownership.¹ Pursuant to a Securities Purchase Agreement dated May 13, 2026, Iridium Monitor Holdings LLC ("Iridium Monitor Holdings"), an indirectly wholly owned subsidiary of Iridium Communications Inc.,² will purchase entities that own all outstanding ownership interests not currently held by its affiliate Iridium Satellite LLC ("Iridium Satellite") in Aireon Holdings (the "Transaction"). In addition, upon closing of the Transaction, Iridium Monitor Holdings will acquire Iridium Satellite's ownership interest in Aireon. Thus, upon closing, which is expected on or shortly after July 1, 2026, Iridium Monitor Holdings will indirectly wholly own Aireon. The Transaction will serve the public interest by enabling Aireon to continue developing its space-based air traffic surveillance system in support of the safe and efficient management of aircraft. The Transaction will also grant Aireon access to Iridium's resources to provide enhanced air traffic surveillance to areas of the world where terrestrial air traffic control is infeasible, such as oceans, polar regions, mountainous regions, jungles, deserts, and conflicted airspace.

Aireon will provide updates on the Transaction consistent with FCC rules.³ Please contact me regarding any questions regarding this matter.
