STATUS REPORT

1. INTRODUCTION

In compliance with the "Special Conditions" of the license granting permission to operate station KM2XDP. This is a progress report which is required to be filed with the FCC, Frequency Liaison Branch. This is the report for the second quarter of 1994.

2. PROGRESS REPORT

Activity in the second quarter of 1994 consisted of occasional transmissions.

The antenna configuration was three 120 degree sectors. Operation was in duplex mode using the uplink and downlink frequencies listed below. Effective radiated power was less than 60 watts on the downlink and less than one watt on the uplink. Both uplink and downlink frequencies were monitored before transmissions.
