Subject: Response for request of FAA Coordination BAE Systems FCC File No.0015-EX-PL-2006.

The FAA concurs with your proposed experimental application provided:

1. The station class on the license is changed from FX to XT.
2. Under no circumstances is the ERP to exceed 182.0 Watts.
3. The applicant is restricted from transmitting on frequencies 1000 and 1200Mhz
4. The applicant agrees to accept and implement any future modifications to their operation as directed by the FAA to include ceasing operations, or adding additional frequency restrictions so that future FAA operational requirements can be supported.
5. These conditions must be listed in the license issued by the FCC

Failure to comply with any of these conditions will render a non-concur by the FAA to the issuance of the requested experimental license. Provided that the applicant can and agrees to adhering to the above conditions, please provide the FAA coordination number NG T070187 along with these conditions and the attached spreadsheet to the FCC for them to include in the application that goes to NTIA.
