I am unsure of exactly what you are requesting in this application. The VHF frequencies have been entered for more than one location, yet the text mentions only the Hudson location. Only the second listing of the Hudson location has bandwidth/emission data, while the first Hudson listing and the Litchfield location do not. Also, the first Hudson listing and the Litchfield location are described as Fixed/Base locations while the VHF frequencies are described as Mobile. The second Hudson location is described as Base and Mobile, yet the frequencies are described as Mobile only. Please explain these discrepancies, given that mobile means transmitting while moving and fixed or base also could mean locations that vary, but all transmissions are while the transmitter is fixed or stationary. Are some operations and/or frequencies fixed and others mobile?

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of September 16, 2002 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
