This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Conditions:

- (1) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) Licensee shall comply with the terms and conditions agreed upon and stated in the application file exhibit titled "International Bureau License Conditions"
- (5) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by U.S. Air Force. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
- (6) POINTS OF COMMUNICATION: EUTELSAT 7A.
- (7) In accordance with Article 4.4 of the ITU Radio Regulations, the operations authorized herein shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from harmful interference caused by, a station operating in accordance with the provisions of the ITU Constitution, the ITU Convention, and the ITU Radio Regulations.

Special Conditions:

- (8) The designated point-of-contact to terminate transmissions if interference occurs is Ron Guzdar, 206-718-5926.
- (9) Operation is subject to coordinate with National Science Foundation (NSF) at esm@nsf.gov prior using the band segment 14.47-14.5 GHz.
- (10) NASA requires coordination for aircraft-to-space operation in the band 14-14.2 GHz and within Radio Line of Sight (RLOS) of its TDRS earth stations at White Sands, NM and Guam. POC is NASA/GSFC Spectrum Manager, Scott Galbraith at 301.286.5089.
