This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Temporary Authority is hereby granted to operate the apparatus described below:

The purpose of this STA operation is to coordinate wireless audio and video transmission for televised sporting events, and other events, at various venues throughout the US.

Special Conditions:

- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) The applicant must obtain consents from the Advanced Wireless Service licensees prior to accessing to the frequency range from 2170 MHz to 2200 MHz.
- (4) Prior to commencing any operations in WCS frequencies (2305-2320 MHz/2345-2360 MHz), the applicant must obtain consent from the WCS licensee (AT&T).
- (5) Operations in the WCS band (2305-2310 MHz) must comply with the emission limits applicable to those bands. See 47 C.F.R. § 27.53(a).
- (6) Prior to commencing operations in the 2200-2290 MHz band, Broadcast Sports International is required to provide the Air Force (jimmy.nguyen@us.af.mil) with stop buzzer point of contact information.
- (7) Broadcast Sports International should be aware that the band 2200-2290 MHz is allocated for federal operations and is an extremely congested band. Non-federal use is on a case-by-case basis with approval of requests for operational and long-term use being highly unlikely. 3G Wireless, LLC. should have no expectations of approval in this band in future submissions.
