

Request for Confidentiality

1. In compliance with §0.459 of the FCC Rules, Cessna Aircraft Company is requesting that exhibits, including the previous request for confidentiality, which had the “confidential” box checked when they were uploaded as attachments to the STA application be held confidential. The exhibits are pdf and MS Word documents as follows: AF Coordination.pdf, FAA Coordination.pdf, Request for Confidentiality.doc and Re AF.pdf.
2. Our customer has a requirement to remain anonymous. The documents specified in item 1 above, for which confidentiality is requested could reveal the customer’s identity.
3. This request for confidentiality has no relation with or to trade secrets, commercial advantage or financial incentive.
4. The information does not pertain to a competitive service.
5. Disclosure of the information will not result in competitive harm.
6. To date, no legal action to prevent unauthorized disclosure of the information has been necessary.
7. This information is not available to the public. Disclosure of this information to third parties is forbidden.
8. This information is to be held confidential until the customer authorizes disclosure. It is not possible to determine how long confidentiality will be required. Therefore, we request that the information be held confidential indefinitely.
9. The equipment under test is already available commercially. The information for which we request confidentiality does not contain any technical information that is not in the public portion of our STA application. We simply wish to test the equipment to ensure that it does not interfere with avionics and navigational systems, and comply with the customer’s requirement to remain anonymous.

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
