Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) Ericsson shall coordinate with the affected Fixed Microwave Service licensees prior to operation in 3700-3800 MHz and 37000-40000 MHz bands.
- (4) Ericsson shall coordinate with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers frequency coordinator prior to operation in 617-652 MHz band to protect the Broadcast Auxiliary Service operations.
- (5) Ericsson must coordinate its operations in 3550-3700 MHz band with one or more authorized Spectrum Access System (SAS) administrators to obtain channel assignments and avoid causing harmful interference to authorized users of the band, including General Authorized Access (GAA) users.
- (6) Prior to commencing any operations in the frequencies below, Ericsson must obtain consent from the following within 50 miles of the contours of the testing area:
Cellular licensees (824-849 MHz/869-894 MHz)
Broadband PCS licensees (1850-1910 MHz/1930-1990 MHz)

Special Conditions:

- (7) Ericsson shall coordinate with the incumbent Fixed Microwave licensee(s) to avoid interference in the 2110-2200 MHz band in each corresponding proposed venue prior to conducting the testing.

- (9) Prior to commencing any operations in the 2180-2190 MHz frequency bands, Ericsson must notify the earth station licensees the test dates and provide a stop buzzer in case of interference.
- (10) Prior to commencing any operations in the 2190-2200 MHz MHz frequency bands, Ericsson must notify the earth station licensees the test dates and provide a stop buzzer in case of interference.
- (11) Prior to commencing any operations in the 3400-3800 MHz frequency bands, Ericsson must notify the earth station licensees the test dates and provide a stop buzzer in case of interference.
- (12) For operations in the 2483.5-2500 MHz band, Ericsson must obtain a written consent from Licensees or remove the band(s).
- (13) For operations in the 3700-3800 MHz band, Ericsson must obtain a written consent from Licensees or remove the band(s).
- (14) All operations in 37000-40000 MHz bands are subject to RES 243 OOB limits of WRC-19.
- (15) Ericsson must secure consents from the Advanced Wireless Service licensees prior to accessing to the frequency range from 2110 MHz to 2200 MHz.
- (16) Ericsson must obtain consents from the Educational Broadband Service and Broadband Radio Service licensees prior to accessing to the frequency range from 2496 MHz to 2690 MHz.
- (17) Ericsson must secure consents from the Upper Microwave Flexible Use Service licensees in the proposed area prior to accessing to 617-652 MHz, 27500-28350 MHz, and 37000-40000 MHz bands.
- (18) Ericsson must coordinate with Fixed Microwave Service licensees in accordance with 47 C.F.R, Part 101.103(d) prior to operation in frequency range from 3700 MHz to 3800 MHz.
- (19) Ericsson must coordinate its operations in 3550-3700 MHz band with one or more authorized Spectrum Access System (SAS) administrators to obtain channel assignments and avoid causing harmful interference to authorized users of the band, including General Authorized Access (GAA) users.
- (20) Prior to commencing any operations in the frequencies below, Ericsson must obtain consent from the following within 50 miles of the contours of the testing area:
 - a. Cellular licensees (824-849 MHz/869-894 MHz)
 - b. Broadband PCS licensees (1850-1910 MHz/1930-1990 MHz)
