1. The Military Assignment Group (MAG) requires a military Point of Contact, with phone number, for use of frequencies in the 225.0-328.6 and 335.4-399.9 MHz bands.
2. Does the applicant anticipate testing related to this filing to extend beyond six months? If so, the applicant should re-file the application on Form 442 for a regular experimental license. See the STA filing guidelines at <http://tinyurl.com/n6yes4>. Filing Guideline (i) states that longer duration experiments should be filed on Form 442 and Filing Guideline (ii) advises the applicant that there is no processing preference for STAs over other applications.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of June 01, 2009 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
