Our 12 engineering undergraduate degree programs are accredited by the Engineering Accreditation Commission of ABET, <http://www.abet.org/>. Iowa State University is accredited by the [Higher Learning Commission](#) of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. All ABET accredited programs undergo review every six years. Our last review was in 2012 with accreditation in 2013.

In order for students or graduates to take the Fundamentals of Engineering examination, the first step towards professional licensure, they must be in or have graduated from an ABET accredited program.
