Dear JOSHUA FOURRIER (KOPA MEDIA),

This refers to application, File No. 0683-EX-CN-2026, for an experimental authorization.

You are advised that the Commission is unable to grant your application for the facilities requested.

Your recent filing seeking Experimental Authority to operate on 103.1 MHz has been reviewed. After evaluation, the Audio Division of the Media Bureau has determined that the request does not satisfy the requirements for experimental authorization.

As noted by the Division, "While submitted as an alleged request for Experimental Authority, the request fails to indicate any new or novel issue or any purpose for operating a station on 103.1 MHz. It simply appears to be an attempt to use the Experimental Authority process to obtain a temporary FM station."

Because the filing does not demonstrate a valid experimental purpose as required under the Commission's rules, your request is hereby dismissed.

Should you wish to pursue authorization for FM broadcast operations, you must do so through the appropriate broadcast licensing procedures.
