Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) NTIA non-concurs to the use of the 5000 – 5250 MHz band.
- (4) Lockheed Martin should have the supporting government agency submit for an SPS review.
- (5) Lockheed Martin should note that the 4400 – 4950 MHz band is allocated for fixed/mobile Federal operations which may not be appropriate for radar systems.
- (6) Operation is not permitted in 4940-4990 MHz band.
