This application proposes the use of microwave channels in the 2 GHz ranges for international video production, during the FIA World Endurance Championship 24-hour automobile race event and for testing prior to and after the event within and immediately surrounding the Circuit of the Americas.

The frequencies requested in this application are part of the S-Band and primarily allocated to Aeronautical Mobile Telemetry, therefore, coordination has been successfully completed with AFTRCC, Aerospace & Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council, Inc., and is attached to this application.

Upon receiving any complaint of interference from a licensed user, operation pursuant to this STA will cease on the channel complained about and will not resume unless and until the interference complaint is resolved satisfactorily to the licensee.
