

Statement Concerned Interference from Proposed Special Temporary Authority

The proposed temporary operation on TV Channel 35 is not expected to cause interference to any operating licensed or proposed facility. An “interference check” was performed using the FCC’s TVStudy software v.2.2.5 and the LMS database as of August 22, 2021, which showed interference to just one station: KVTE-LD, Channel 35, Las Vegas Nevada. However, the Commission LMS records show this station has been silent since September 2, 2021 and expects to remain silent until February 3, 2022 due to “problems with the video server.” See LMS File No. 0000156957. Therefore, no actual interference to any station is expected.

A search of the FCC’s ELS database did not show any proposed operation on Channel 35 that would conflict with the proposed temporary operation.

In addition, the proposed operation will be within a metal-skin building (Las Vegas Convention Center) and at relatively low power.

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
