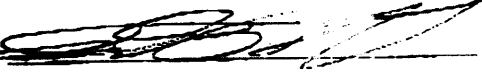
RE: Experimental License on F Block frequencies in BTA 101 (Dallas, TX)

Cingular Wireless, on behalf of its affiliate, Southwestern Bell Wireless, LLC, (collectively "Cingular") and Navini Networks ("Navini") hereby agree that Navini may perform drive testing of the referenced spectrum (1890-1895 MHz) for which Cingular holds the license in the Dallas BTA, under the following terms and conditions:

- Navini may not utilize the referenced spectrum until it has obtained a valid experimental license thereon, and must immediately cease utilizing the spectrum if the license is revoked or otherwise expires. Navini will provide Cingular with a copy of the experimental license and will immediately notify Cingular of any revocation or other expiration;
- Navini will in no event utilize the referenced spectrum beyond July 1, 2004;
- Navini's use of the spectrum shall be limited to a transmitter at the following location, operating under the following parameters:
 - North latitude 32-58 44, West longitude 96-44-05 (Navini's headquarters at 2240 Campbell Creek Blvd. Suite 110, Richardson, TX 75082)
 - Antenna height 100 feet
 - Transmitter power 100 W
 - All mobile devices will operate within 10km of this transmitter;
- Prior to each transmission, Navini will notify Cingular of the anticipated start and end times of the transmission via e-mail to Jerry LaBerteaux at jerry.laberteaux@navini.com;
- Navini will immediately discontinue all transmissions at any time upon Cingular's request;
- In the event of any reported interference, Navini will immediately cease transmitting and will cooperate with the resolution of all interference.

Please indicate Navini Networks' acceptance of these terms by having this letter agreement executed below.

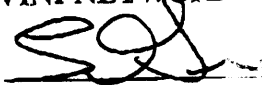
