Message:

Near Space Launch Inc. (NSL) is the owner and operator of the ground station that is licensed. NSL controls the ground station.

The ground station has historically provided a means to send a stop transmission command for satellites using the Globalstar EyeStar-S3 transmitter, supplied by NSL. I do not recall that we have ever been asked by a satellite owner/operator to send this command, but the capability exists. If the satellite owner/operator would receive a shutdown request, NSL would send the command.

This latest license modification adds to the satellites for which this capability is provided. Other aspects of the license remain as they have been for several years.

We expect that with the introduction of Globalstar simplex receive equipment, the requirement for this feature would "sunset". Until then, the ground station is in place to provide the kill command should it be required.
