Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.

Special Conditions:

- (3) a. Prior to operation in 2417-2483.5 MHz band, licensee must successfully coordinate with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers frequency coordinator and the existing and future Fixed Microwave Service licensees in accordance with 47 CFR, Part 101.103(d).

b. Licensee must consult the ULS database to ensure that the operation will not cause harmful interference to any existing registered stations in the 3650-3700 MHz band, and notify the registered users in the proposed geographic area prior to operation in 2950-3650 MHz band.
- (4) Prior to commencing any operations in the frequencies below, Northrop Grumman Systems Corporation must obtain consent from the following within 50 miles of the contours of the testing area:
 - > Location & Monitoring Service licensees (902-928 MHz)
- (5) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.
- (6) THE FOLLOWING CONDITION APPLIES TO THE OPERATION IN THE 2417-2483.5 MHz BAND. UPON NOTIFICATION FROM THE FCC, OPERATION ON THIS ASSIGNMENT IS SUBJECT TO IMMEDIATE CESSATION, IF IT CAUSES HARMFUL INTERFERENCE TO FEDERAL LICENSEES.
- (7) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by AFRL/RQKDA Contract Number FA8650-18-C-7841. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
- (8) Licensee must successfully coordinate with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers frequency coordinator in the proposed area prior to operation in the frequency band from 2450 MHz to 2483.5 MHz
- (9) Licensee must successfully coordinate with the Fixed Microwave Service licensees in the proposed area in accordance with 47 C.F.R, Part 101.103(d) prior to operation in the frequency band from 2450 MHz to 2483.5 MHz.
- (10) Licensee must successfully coordinate with the Advanced Wireless Service licensees in the proposed area prior to accessing to the frequency band from 1695 MHz to 1780 MHz.
