Please refer to justification for CONUS operations, which was submitted as an attachment to the previous renewal application for Station WC2XXH under File No. 0078-EX-RR-2005, which was granted by the FCC. The program (airborne radar) related to this license continues to have the need for CONUS operations due to the testing using a test bed aircraft. While testing will occur the majority of the time in the lab at the Linthicum facility, there also continues to be the need to test in the air at military locations.

Currently, about 90% of the time, the testing is in the lab. Current flight test operations is greatly reduced, but that could change in the near future.

When performing Local flight test, they operate in the following areas (note percent is just to give an approximate indication of time operating over a particular state):

1. Maryland (95%)
2. Delaware (2%)
3. Pennsylvania (0.5%)
4. Virginia (2%)
5. West Virginia (0.5%)

If they are on a deployment to military cites, which is usually 1 week to 2 weeks at most, the states were most of the testing occurs are: (there is no significance to the order).

1. California
2. New Mexico
3. Texas
4. Nevada
5. Colorado
