Dear Mr. Patterson,

This letter will serve as authorization from Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless to grant Oceus Networks use of the 700 MHz Lower A Block spectrum in the Washington, DC area with the following conditions:

Location of Use: Washington, DC

Dates of Use: August 1, 2013 – November 1, 2013

Intended Use of Spectrum: The spectrum will be used for a temporary video surveillance system, operated by Oceus Networks on and around the National Mall, in conjunction with the 50th Anniversary of Martin Luther King's "I Have a Dream Speech" on August 28 and the Marine Corps Marathon on October 27. Oceus intends to utilize the spectrum for this dedicated public safety application, and it proposes to seek a Special Temporary Authority (STA) from the FCC to allow this temporary operation.

This authorization is not intended for commercial use or for long term use of the spectrum (beyond the timeframe identified above). This authorization may not be transferred for use at any other location without the express approval of Verizon Wireless as only the above location has been analyzed and cleared for use.
