Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) All customers participating in the experiment shall be informed that this operation is for experimental purposes only and can be cancelled at any time.
- (3) Prior to equipment authorization or a determination of compliance, the device must be accompanied by a conspicuous notice worded as follows: "This device has not been authorized as required by the rules of the Federal Communications Commission. This device is not, and may not be, offered for sale or lease, or sold or leased, until authorization is obtained."
- (4) Licensee should be aware that U.S. Air Force radar operations are licensed in the band 3395-3399 MHz and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (5) No WiMax equipment shall be developed for U.S. sales in the band 3300-3650 MHz since it is a federal government band for radiolocation. Any development for U. S. sales needs to be done in an approved FCC band.
