

EXHIBIT 3 REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT

Raytheon respectfully requests confidential treatment of *Exhibit 2 Description of Confidential Information* submitted with this application ("Exhibit 2") pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act and the Commission's rules.¹ As described below, this request meets the standards for confidential treatment:

1. *Identification of the specific information for which confidential treatment is sought.*

The specific information is contained in Exhibit 2.

2. *Identification of the Commission proceeding in which the information was submitted or description of the circumstances giving rise to the submission.*

FCC Form 442 request for modification of an existing license.

3. *Explanation of the degree to which the information is commercial or financial, or contains a trade secret or is privileged.*

Exhibit 2 contains confidential information that, if disclosed, would cause significant harm to Raytheon.

4. *Explanation of the degree to which the information concerns a service that is subject to competition.*

Raytheon is one of several manufacturers of commercial and military radars.

5. *Explanation of how disclosure of the information could result in substantial competitive harm.*

Disclosure of Raytheon's product development processes could give competitors an unfair advantage.

6. *Identification of any measures taken by the submitting party to prevent unauthorized disclosure.*

Raytheon requires third parties to execute a non-disclosure agreement ("NDA") prior to disclosure of confidential information, and only discloses such information to employees on a need-to-know basis.

7. *Identification of whether the information is available to the public and the extent of any previous disclosure of the information to third parties.*

This information is not available to the public, and any disclosure to third parties would have been pursuant to an NDA.

- 8. *Justification of the period during which the submitting party asserts that material should be available for public disclosure.***

Raytheon requests that Exhibit 2 be treated confidentially for an infinite period of time since it contains information about Raytheon's product development process.

- 9. *Any other information that the party seeking confidential treatment believes may be useful in assessing whether its request for confidentiality should be granted.***
