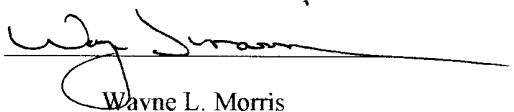
Testing will be accomplished in conjunction with current licenses KMC6 and N206PD.
