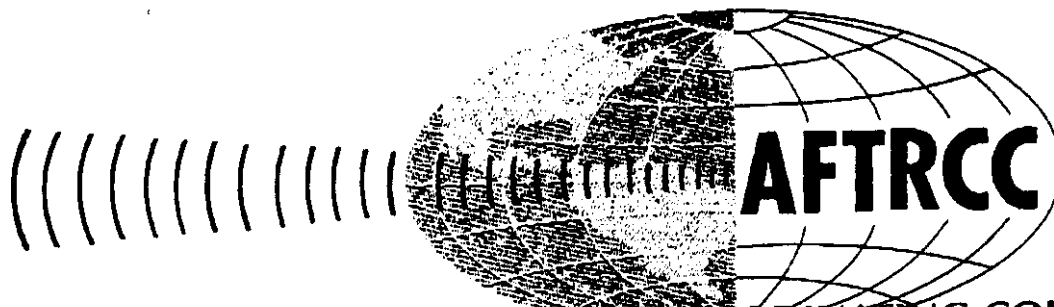

Power	:	30 Watts (both Fixed and Aeronautical Mobile)
Restriction	:	Aircraft is restricted to radiating at 10,000 ft. or below for data testing.

Testing will be accomplished in conjunction with current license(s) KMC6 and N206PD for data line evaluation.
