Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Pulse duration and repetition rate:
0.45 microsecond pulses with a repetition rate max 6750 per second,
0.50 microsecond pulses with a repetition rate max 5600 per second,
Maximum duty cycle of 0.58%,
Operational duty cycle would be much less.
- (4) The FAA CONCURS with the subject application provided that the following condition is included in the FCC application/license: "It is required that the following FAA facilities be coordinated prior to the operation of any transponder equipment that has not been certified as meeting the applicable FAA Technical Standard Orders (TSO):
