Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) Licensee shall be aware that FSS earth stations are licensed above 3700 MHz and if any interference occurs, the experimental licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) The applicant must coordinate its operations in the 3550-3700 MHz band with one or more authorized Spectrum Access System (SAS) administrators to obtain channel assignments and avoid causing harmful interference to authorized users of the band, including General Authorized Access (GAA) users.
- (5) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.
- (6) This authorization SUPERSEDES the previously issued authorization with the same call sign and file number to extend the expiration date to 09/07/2022.
