Mr. Nguyen, Thank you for your inquiry. The applicant, Saronic Technologies, Inc., has not removed any previously authorized locations under call sign WQ2XOF and continues to need each of them. The sole purpose of this modification is to add one new antenna site to the existing authorization. The Experimental Licensing System (ELS) form reflects that purpose. For a modification application, the form asks the applicant to identify the purpose of the request and offers the options to add, edit, or delete an antenna site. Saronic selected "Add" for the single new site. Because the application makes no change to the previously authorized sites, those sites do not appear on the form. Their absence from the form is a function of how ELS displays modification requests and does not indicate any request to delete them. The narrative statement accompanying the application states the same point: Saronic is adding one new site in addition to the previously authorized sites. If the Office of Engineering and Technology would prefer that the previously authorized locations be listed on the form as well, we can revise the application to duplicate the existing site locations that are unchanged while the form remains pending. Please let us know how you would like to proceed, and we will make the change promptly. We appreciate your attention to this application and are happy to answer any further questions.
