

Exhibit A – Description of Modification

By this application, SkyTerra Subsidiary LLC (“SkyTerra”), formerly Mobile Satellite Ventures Subsidiary LLC (“MSV”), hereby submits this modification application requesting authority for an additional location for testing (Reston, Virginia) and to make two administrative changes to its authorization, Call Sign WE2XVT, which are discussed below. There are no other changes proposed in this modification application.

On the original FCC Form 442 application submitted for this authorization, File No. 0421-EX-PL-2008, SkyTerra indicated that the two transmitter locations were “fixed” and explained in the associated Exhibit A that this meant a transportable transmitter would be located within a 10-mile radius of each location specified on the form. At FCC staff’s request, we are changing this classification to “mobile.”

On December 9, 2009, SkyTerra notified the FCC that it had changed its corporate name from MSV to SkyTerra and listed the affected FCC licenses and applications, including this authorization. See attached Exhibit B. SkyTerra requests that OET update its database to reflect the new corporate name.¹
