Please address the following questions/concerns from the Space Bureau and please inform me via direct email once this is complete:

1. First, the exhibit describes the request as pertaining to the operation of earth stations located on launch vehicles and spacecraft. However, this description does not align with the definition of earth stations as outlined in 47 CFR 25.103, and this has been noted previously regarding similar requests, such as ELS File No. 0601-EX-ST-2026.
2. Additionally, they should revise the Station Locations section to include all locations where experimental operations are planned. This has been accomplished in previous filings by specifying, for example: MOBILE: launch vehicle stage 1, suborbital, SP; or MOBILE: non-geostationary, suborbital, SP.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of June 16, 2026 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
