Please provide the filing numbers for the US Earth stations.
Please update the 8025 – 8400 MHz entry in the spacecap to match what's provided in your waiver request (space research). Is the 400.15 – 401 MHz uplink supposed to be space research as well?

Please provide responses to the following requirements:

- 47 CFR 5.107 – how transmissions from the spacecraft can be ceased
- 47 CFR 5.64(b)(4)(i)(C) – transit through inhabitable space station altitudes
- 47 CFR 5.64(b)(4)(i)(D) – orbital tolerances
- 47 CFR 5.64(b)(4)(i)(E) – certification of space situational awareness conjunction warning and cooperation with other operators
- 47 CFR 5.64(b)(5)(i) – whether space station tracking will be active or passive
- 47 CFR 5.64(b)(5)(iii) – extent to which the operator will share information regarding initial deployment and planned maneuvers with the 18th and other operators
- 47 CFR 5.64(b)(7) – will any fuel be reserved for disposal maneuvers, and if so, what quantity

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of May 29, 2026 may result in application dismissal pursuant to 47 CFR § 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to 47 CFR § 1.1111.
