INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING FCC FORM 405

A. Submit two (2) copies of the completed FCC Form 405 to the Federal Communications Commission at the address for the appropriate service for which you are filing. Current fee amounts and mailing addresses can be found in the Fee Filing Guide applicable to the service in which filing. Part 5 applicants should refer to the Office of Engineering and Technology Fee Filing Guide and are required to submit only one copy of FCC Form 405. Part 21 applicants should refer to the Mass Media Fee Filing Guide; Part 22 and Part 101 applicants should refer to the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau Fee Filing Guide; and Part 23 and Part 25 applicants should refer to the International Bureau Fee Filing Guide.

C. A fee is required to be filed with this application. Refer to 47 CFR 1.1105 or the appropriate fee filing guide for the service in which filing to determine the current fee for this application. Several methods of payment are available and are detailed in the fee filing guides.
