This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) Tecore must have consent letters from all broadband PCS licensees for A and D blocks 1850-1870 MHz / 1930-1950 MHz within 50 miles from the test area.
- (4) Tecore, Inc. must get consents from the Advanced Wireless Service licensees prior to accessing to 1775-1815 MHz band.
- (5) At least 3 days prior to the start of all operational dates and times, Tecore must complete coordination with the NASA Goddard Spaceflight Center (GSFC) Spectrum Manager, SCOTT GALBRAITH at 301-286-5089, VINCENT.S.GALBRAITH@NASA.GOV.
