Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) This frequency assignment in one of the bands 1435-1525, 2310-2320 and 2345-2390 MHz was coordinated prior to its authorization with AFMO CONUS, Ft. Sam Houston, TX, who also coordinated it, as appropriate, with the Aerospace and Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council. Use of this frequency under the authority of this assignment is subject to such further coordination with AFMO CONUS, Ft. Sam Houston, TX, as necessary to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
- (3) All customers participating in the experiment shall be informed that this operation is for experimental purposes only and can be cancelled at any time.
- (4) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (5) The applicant must coordinate with the local Society of Broadcast Engineer frequency coordinator and the Fixed Microwave Service licensees prior to operation in 2300-2500 MHz band.
- (6) The applicant must be "notification" of Location & Monitoring Service licensees (902-928 MHz) within 100 miles of the test area.
- (7) This frequency assign was coordinated prior to authorization with FAA Headquarters, 800 Independence Avenue, S.W., Washington, D.C 20591. Phone: 202-267-8699.
- (8) During transmission, aircraft shall not exceed the altitude listed in the circuit remarks field 1500 ft. AGL.
- (9) These tests will not be associated with any jamming activity.
