Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) Prior to commencing any operations, the applicant must obtain consent from the following within 50 miles of the contours of the testing area:
Paging Service licensees in 35 MHz
Paging Service licensees in 43 MHz
AMTS Licensee (217-218 MHz/219-220 MHz)
218-219 MHz Service licensees
- (4) Operations are on a strict non-interference basis (NIB) and shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference and notify the FCC in writing.
- (5) The Boeing Company must notch out the following:
a. 36.37 MHz (+/- 12.5 kHz)
b. 46.77 MHz (+/- 12.5 kHz)
c. 138 - 148 MHz band
d. 403-406 MHz band

- (6) Future STA requests to extend this authorization will not be considered.
