Has your school obtained approval from NASA or any other federal agency to operate across these entire bands? If not, the school should file for only a specific frequency for testing.
- As requested on July 15th, 2026, please change the frequency band and emission designator bandwidth to match the information on the NTIA Space Record Data. Please pay attention to the emission designator bandwidth as well.
