Dear Mr. Wright:

Attached in duplicate is FCC Form 442 and related exhibits. This application seeks to modify an existing experimental authorization to preform a PCS wireless access trial in Boulder, Colorado. U S WEST is proposing to:

1. Increase the authorized power from 126 milliwatts (ERP) to 10 watts (ERP).
2. Extend the location of the station to include the geographic region within a 30 mile radius of Boulder, Colorado.

U S WEST requests these changes in order to test a wider variety of Personal Communications Service (PCS) technologies. The extension of the geographical coverage area is necessary to preform PCS experiments in a heavy urban environment with large, high-rise buildings. All other parameters will remain the same.

Also attached is FCC form 155 and a check for the amount of \$35.00 to cover the required filing fee.
