WSERIES10 will meet the regulation set forth in 47 CFR 5.64(b)(5)(i) by actively monitoring downlinked transmissions to authorized Earth stations to identify the spacecraft after deployment. WSERIES10 has a unique frequency pair independent from other spacecraft, as well as unique telemetry-based identifiers specific to the WSERIES10 spacecraft, to ensure TT&C from the spacecraft is not mistakenly identified as another. In regard to the part of the question stating "immediately following deployment", the word "immediately" is not used anywhere in 47 CFR 5.64(b)(5)(i). Identification is done at the first possible opportunity following deployment, but the timing of this is variable up until launch day and is highly dependent on time of separation from the launch vehicle, orbital geometry to an authorized Earth station, as well as scheduling constraints of the Earth stations themselves.
