Statement of Purpose

- a. The complete program of research and experimentation proposed including description of equipment and theory of operation.** IEEE 802.16d is in the final stages of balloting within IEEE. Intel and Fujitsu are two chip vendors that are committed to producing chipsets for 802.16 variants. These chipsets are expected to be available early 2005.
- b. The specific objectives sought to be accomplished.** Objective of this project is to thoroughly investigate the feasibility of using various variants of 802.16 as a technology for T-Mobile.
- c. How the program of experimentation has a reasonable promise of contribution to the development, extension, expansion or utilization of the radio art, or is along a line not already investigated.** The project will focus on soliciting input from vendors, building a test environment for multiple use cases, and obtaining all necessary input for pre-commercial system readiness.
