INTRODUCTIONS

Congratulations on your purchase of the CDB-234BT CD/FM RADIO. For your safety and to get the most enjoyment from your player, please completely read these instructions provided.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

READ THIS MANUAL CAREFULLY BEFORE OPERATING AND RESERVE IT FOR FUTURE REFERENCE. REFER TO IT WHEN ENCOUNTERING ANY OPERATING PROBLEM.

- 1. WARNING: To reduce the risk of electric shock or damage to the player's main speakers, do not disassemble the player. There are no user-serviceable parts inside. Contact technical support for further assistance.
- 2. WARNING: To prevent fire or electric shock hazard, do not expose the player to rain or moisture (including drips or splashes). Objects filled with liquids, such as vases and water bottles, should not be placed on or near the player.
- 3. WARNING: Do not expose the radio/cassette player or batteries to excessive heat, such as direct sunlight, fire, or other heat sources.
- 4. WARNING: Use only the attachments/accessories provided by the manufacturer, except for a standard 3.5 mm auxiliary cable.
- 5. Do not place objects on top of the player.
- 6. Do not place the player on an unstable table, stand, tripod, bracket or cart. The player may fall, resulting in possible damage or injury.
- 7. Unplug the power from the outlet during lightning storms or when the player is not in use.
- 8. Pay attention to the safety purpose of the polarized or grounding-type plug. A polarized plug has two blades with one wider than the other. A grounding type plug has two blades and a third grounding prong. The wide blade and/or the third prong are provided for your safety. If the provided plug does not fit into your outlet, consult an electrician for replacement of the obsolete outlet.
- 9. Protect the POWER cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the player.

- 10. Dispose of this player properly, respecting your local laws for electronics and battery disposal.

GENERAL INFORMATION

FEATURES

- CD Boombox can play CD, MP3, CD-R, and CD-RW discs
- LED front panel display
- Audio CDs and MP3 discs are divided into tracks

PLEASE NOTE

- You cannot play DVDs/video discs.
- You cannot play illegally produced discs.
- You cannot play scratched discs.
- You cannot play discs that are dirty (dusty, soiled, marked with finger prints, etc.)

The drawings of the front panel display used in this manual are solely for illustration purposes. The actual display may differ slightly.

DISC HANDLING PRECAUTIONS

- To keep the disc clean, handle the disc by its edge.
- Do not touch the surface.
- Do not stick paper on the disc.
- If there is glue (or similar substance) on the disc, remove the glue completely before using the disc.
- *
- Do not leave the disc in a vehicle parked in direct sunlight. Heat may damage the CD. Do not expose discs to direct sunlight.
- After use, store discs in protective case.
- Do not write on the label of the disc with ball point pens, or other sharp writing device.
- Do not drop or bend discs.

DISC CLEANING PRECAUTIONS

• Before playing, clean disc with a cleaning cloth. Wipe from the center of



the disc to the outer edge.

- DO NOT wipe in a circular fashion, this will damage the disc, and may not be functional.
- DO NOT use solvents such as benzene, thinner, commercially available cleaners, or anti-static spray intended for vinyl LPs.

DISC INSTALLATION PRECAUTIONS

- DO NOT install more than 1 disc on the disc tray at a time.
- DO NOT place the disc on the tray upside down.
- DO NOT try to close the disc tray when the disc is not properly installed.

PLAYER CONTROLS

1. POWER (**心**)

To turn the unit ON/OFF.

2. REPEAT/MODE (← / MODE)

Short press = REPEAT MODE will be switched ON, ONE/REPEAT ALL/ RANDOM Function

Long press (3-4 seconds) = AUX/CD/USB/FM/BT will be switched ON


3. PLAY/PAUSE (►■■)/SCAN

To play/pause in CD/USB/BT mode

To scan FM stations in FM Radio mode; long press to automatically scan; short press to store desired stations, use TUN+ and TUN- to switch between stations

4. EQ/STOP (EQ/ **■**)

Short press = switch to EQ function and select your desired effect: JAZZ/ROCK/POP/CLASSIC



Long press (3-4 seconds) = switch the STOP function on under CD/USB mode

5. PREV/TUNING- (**M**/TUN−)

IN CD/USB/BT mode: PREV, previous track; long press to fast reverse IN FM Radio mode: TUN-, previous FM radio station; long press for semi-automatic function

6. NEXT/TUNING+ (►) /TUN+)

IN CD/USB/BT mode: NEXT, next track; long press for fast forward IN FM Radio mode: TUN+, next FM radio station; long press for semi-automatic function



CONNECTIONS

AUX AUDIO INPUT DESCRIPTION

The AUX audio input signal should not be higher than 1v. Press the "MODE" key on the front panel to change to AUX mode. You can use the VOL +/- on the player to adjust the volume level.

BATTERY INSTALLATION (BATTERY EXCLUDED)

- 1. Open the battery cover.
- 2. Place 4 D-size batteries (UM-1, 1.5V) into the battery case. Maintain correct placement by matching the "+" and "-" signs with the battery. Please note: If this unit will not be used for a long period of time remove batteries before storing unit.

BLUETOOTH CONNECTION

Press mode button on the front panel to select Bluetooth (BT) mode.

When the correct mode has been selected, open your Bluetooth device, connect to "CDB234". After connection is complete, play audio from your device.

TROUBLESHOOTING

PROBLEM	SOLUTION
No power to unit.	 Main power is not connected, connect power cord to power outlet. Power button is turned to OFF. Turn power button to ON.
Compact Disc does not play.	 "NO DISC" appears on screen, disc tray is empty, insert CD. "NO DISC" appears on screen, disc tray contains upside down disc. Reload disc correctly. "NO DISC" appears on screen, disc tray contains damaged or scratched disc. Replace with undamaged CD. "NO DISC" appears on screen, disc tray contains dirty disc. Clean disc and replace.

No sound. Sound out of only one speaker.

- Wrong audio output setting. Switch to proper setting.
- Poor or missing cable connection. Replace cable connection. Check connections
