These exhibits are included in the responses to supplemental questions for Correspondence Reference Number: 31604 for the Equipment Certification of the HST-2110 Aeronautical Satellite Communications Transceiver (FCC ID: **AJK8222231**).

The exhibits for the Schematic Diagram and the Internal Photographs have information concerning signal processing methods and also contain very detailed pictures of the circuit cards in the equipment. Rockwell Collins does not ordinarily request confidentiality for the internal photos; however, the manufacturer of the circuit cards (EMS SATCOM Technologies) has requested that this information be withheld. The information in the Schematic Diagram and Internal Photographs is confidential and is customarily guarded from competitors. If a competitor were to obtain this information, it could be use the information to reverse engineer the HST-2110. As a result, the FCC should protect this information from public disclosure under Exemption 4 of the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(4)) because disclosing the information could reasonably be expected to cause substantial competitive harm to Rockwell Collins, Inc.
