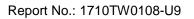

r = distance between observation point and center of the radiator in cm

Pd is the limit of MPE, 1mW/cm<sup>2</sup>. If we know the maximum gain of the antenna and the total power input to the antenna, through the calculation, we will know the distance r where the MPE limit is reached.

Both of the WLAN 2.4GHz Band, WLAN 5GHz Band and BLE Band can transmit simultaneously. The max Power Density at R (20 cm) = 0.0030mW/cm<sup>2</sup> + 0.3197mW/cm<sup>2</sup> + 0.7616mW/cm<sup>2</sup> = 1.0843mW/cm<sup>2</sup> > 1mW/cm<sup>2</sup>.

The max Power Density at R (21 cm) = 0.0027mW/cm<sup>2</sup> + 0.2900mW/cm<sup>2</sup> + 0.6908mW/cm<sup>2</sup> = 0.9835mW/cm<sup>2</sup> < 1mW/cm<sup>2</sup>.

Therefore, the Min Safety Distance is 21cm.
