Pursuant to Section 1.768 of the FCC’s rules, Antilles Crossing-St. Croix, Inc. (“ACSC”) (FRN 0013963624), the holder of a submarine cable landing license to operate the Antilles Crossing private fiber-optic cable system (File No. SCL-LIC-20031125-00032), hereby notifies the Commission of new foreign carrier affiliations which it will acquire in Barbados and St. Lucia pursuant to the proposed transfer of control of ACSC from Global Caribbean Fiber SAS (“GCF”) to Fibre Investments Holdings Limited IBC (“FIHL”).¹ ACSC owns the subsea portion of the Antilles Crossing system in U.S. territorial waters and the St. Croix cable landing station. An application for transfer of control of ACSC from GCF to FIHL is being filed concurrently with this notice.

5. Interlocking Directorates

ACSC will have no interlocking directorates.

6. Date of Closing

The consummation of the proposed transaction through which FIHL will acquire control of ACSC will take place following the FCC's approval of the transaction and the satisfaction of any other conditions to closing.

7. Market Power Showing

ACSC's proposed new foreign carrier affiliates in Barbados and St. Lucia lack market power in their destination markets. Digicel (St. Lucia) Limited and Digicel (Barbados) Limited provide mobile voice, data, and broadband services in St. Lucia and Barbados, respectively. Both St. Lucia and Barbados are members of the World Trade Organization. In both St. Lucia and Barbados, Digicel (St. Lucia) Limited and Digicel

(Barbados) Limited hold less than fifty percent market share in the international transport and local access markets. Moreover, Digicel (St. Lucia) Limited and Digicel (Barbados) Limited do not appear on the FCC's list of foreign telecommunications carriers presumed to possess market power in foreign telecommunications markets. Consequently, ACSC's proposed new foreign carrier affiliates in Barbados and St. Lucia qualify for a presumption of non-dominance pursuant to Section 63.10(a)(3) of the FCC's rules, exemption from the reporting requirements in Section 1.767(l) of the FCC's rules, and notification of the foreign carrier affiliations described herein pursuant to Section 1.768(c) of the FCC's rules.
