Description of Services and Facilities; Streamlined Processing Statement; Certifications

Applicant: TeleArc LLC

TeleArc LLC (“Applicant”) submits this description, statement, and the certifications below in support of its application for Global Resale Authority pursuant to Section 63.18(e)(2) of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18(e)(2).

1. Prior Section 214 Authority (47 C.F.R. § 63.18(d))

The Applicant has not previously held or been granted any international Section 214 authority.

2. Description of Services

The Applicant will provide wholesale U.S.-international telecommunications services on a carrier-to-carrier (business-to-business) basis by reselling the authorized U.S.-international common carrier services of other authorized U.S. carriers. Specifically, the Applicant will operate as a wholesale voice transit aggregator, routing international voice traffic between carrier-grade counterparties. The Applicant does not, and will not, provide service directly to end users or retail consumers in the United States.

3. Description of Facilities

The Applicant operates a session border controller (SBC) and softswitch platform hosted on cloud compute infrastructure located within the United States. The Applicant interconnects with the networks of other authorized carriers via Session Initiation Protocol (SIP) over Internet Protocol transport. The Applicant does not own or operate international transmission facilities and will rely on the authorized facilities of underlying U.S.-international carriers to carry traffic to international points.

4. Destination Countries

The Applicant requests global resale authority to provide service to all international points, consistent with Section 63.18(e)(2) of the Commission’s rules. The Applicant is not affiliated with any foreign carrier in any destination country.

5. Statement Supporting Streamlined Processing (47 C.F.R. § 63.12)

The Applicant respectfully requests streamlined processing of this application pursuant to Section 63.12 of the Commission’s rules and demonstrates its eligibility as follows:

- (a) The Applicant seeks only global resale authority under Section 63.18(e)(2), which is expressly eligible for streamlined processing.
- (b) The Applicant is not a foreign carrier and is not affiliated with any foreign carrier in any destination country. Accordingly, the Applicant is not subject to dominant carrier regulation on any U.S.-international route under Section 63.10 of the Commission’s rules.

(c) The Applicant is a limited liability company organized under the laws of Colorado, with its principal place of business, operations, and infrastructure located entirely within the United States.

(d) The Applicant's sole member is a lawful permanent resident of the United States who resides and conducts business in the United States. The Applicant has designated a U.S.-based point of contact who is a lawful permanent resident of the United States for the execution of lawful requests, in compliance with Section 63.18(q)(1)(iii) of the Commission's rules.

(e) None of the circumstances set forth in Section 63.12(c) of the Commission's rules that would render an application ineligible for streamlined processing applies to this application.

6. Certifications

(a) The Applicant certifies that it will comply with the terms and conditions set forth in Section 63.21 (conditions applicable to all international Section 214 authorizations) and Section 63.23 (conditions applicable to resale-based international common carriers) of the Commission's rules.

(b) The Applicant certifies, pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 853a, that no party to this application is subject to a denial of Federal benefits that includes FCC benefits by a Federal or State court.

(c) The Applicant certifies that it has not agreed to accept, and will not agree to accept, special concessions from any foreign carrier as described in Section 63.14 of the Commission's rules.

(d) The Applicant certifies that it will comply with the national security, law enforcement, foreign intelligence, and public safety certifications required of international Section 214 authorization holders under Section 63.18(p) of the Commission's rules, and will respond to any Standard Questions as required.
