The Company later changed its name to North American Telecommunications Corporation; however, it is not clear from the Commission's website list of current Section 214 license holders that this name change was effectively noticed to the Commission.

(Response to Question 13)

Description of Transaction

This filing notifies the Commission regarding a pro forma intracorporate reorganization involving the assignment of regulated assets and authority from North American Telecommunications Corporation (NATC), a company holding domestic and international Section 214 authority, to a commonly-owned affiliate, Broadsmart Florida, Inc. (Broadsmart). Pre-close, NATC held blanket domestic Section 214 authority as well as an international Section 214 authorization issued under File No. ITC-214-20010508-00295 on May 30, 2001. Post-close, this domestic and international Section 214 authority, as well as the associated operating assets and customer accounts², has been assigned to Broadsmart. Consequently, effective with the consummation of the transaction, Broadsmart now operates as the regulated provider of services. Following the transaction, NATC no longer holds section 214 authority and no longer provides regulated services.

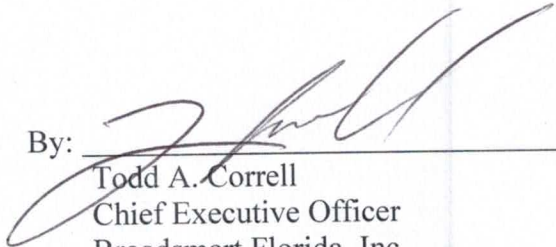
