Pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, ("the Act"), 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.24(f) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.24(f), the Commission is hereby notified of the *pro forma partial* assignment of international Section 214 authorization File No. ITC-214-20011116-00601 from T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("Assignor") to Sprint Communications Company L.P. ("Assignee" or "SCCLP"). Both Assignor and Assignee are indirect wholly owned subsidiaries of T-Mobile US, Inc. ("T-Mobile") and thus ultimate control of the authorizations has not changed. The transaction, which occurred on October 7, 2022, was part of an effort to streamline the international Section 214 authorizations of certain T-Mobile subsidiaries.

Thus, FRG is deemed to hold approximately 30.46 percent of DT. As such, FRG is deemed to hold approximately a 14.70 percent attributable equity interest and a 30.46 percent attributable voting interest in SCCLP.

Answer to Question 13:

The Commission is hereby notified of the *pro forma* partial assignment of international Section 214 authorization File No. ITC-214-20011116-00601 from T-Mobile USA, Inc. to SCCLP as the result of efforts to streamline the international Section 214 authorizations of certain T-Mobile subsidiaries.³ The partial assignment occurred on October 7, 2022. Please note that the partial assignment will not result in any discontinuance of or diminution in service to customers because Assignor is retaining all of its authority. Attached are charts showing the ownership of the Assignor and Assignee.

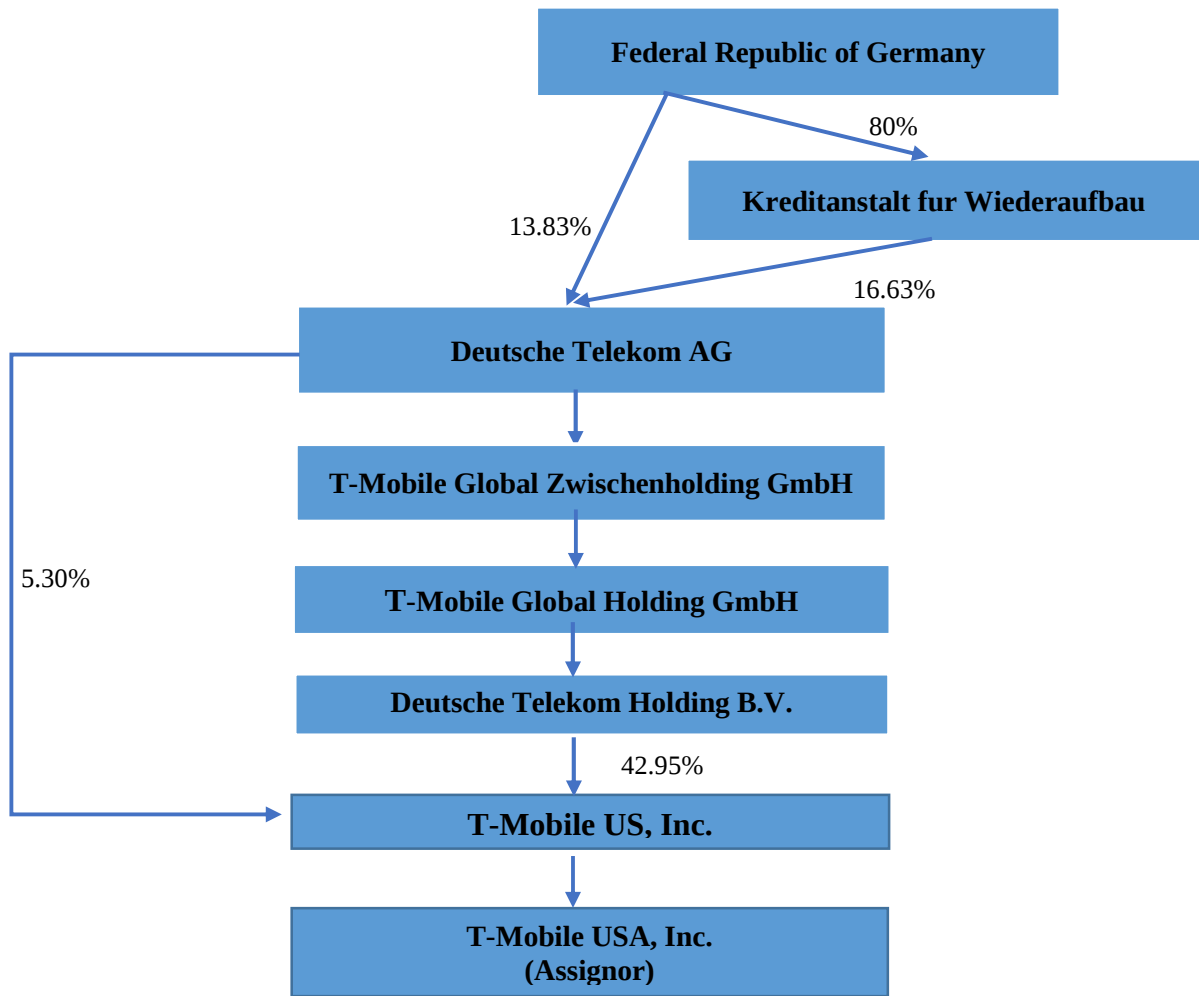
Because the partial assignment did not change the ultimate control of the authorization, it was *pro forma* in nature.⁴ The Commission has stated that, in situations “where no substantial change of control will result from the transfer or assignment, grant of the application is deemed presumptively in the public interest.”⁵

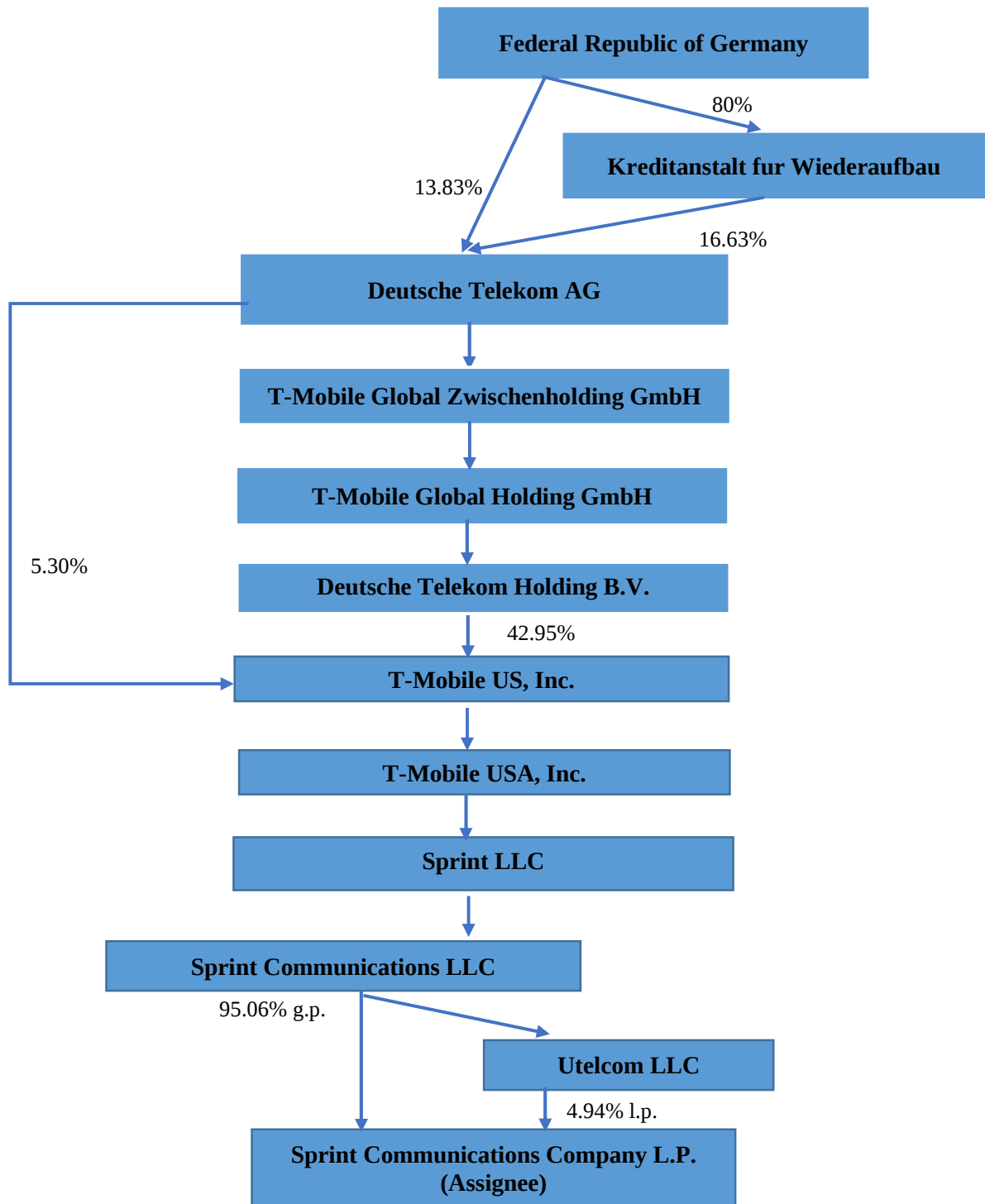
