Dear Ms. Dortch,

On July 2, 2020, BT Americas Holdings Inc. (“BTAH”) and CIH Telecommunications Americas, LLC (“CIH”) submitted to the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) an application for the approval of the transfer of control of BTAH’s subsidiary, BT LatAm Inc. (“BT LatAm”, together with BTAH and CIH, the “Applicants”) to CIH (the “Application”). By this letter, the Applicants hereby withdraw the Application’s request related to transfer of control of domestic Section 214 authority.

BT LatAm operates pursuant to the international Section 214 authorization held by its indirect parent, BTAH¹ and the Application sought approval of the transfer of control of BT LatAm’s regulated operating assets and customers. Out of an abundance of caution, the Application also sought approval, to the extent necessary, for the transfer of control of any domestic Section 214 authority that might be deemed associated with BT LatAm equipment that is located in the United States but used only for international services.

In response to an FCC staff query, BT LatAm confirms that it has no domestic operations and, pursuant to FCC staff direction, the Applicants hereby withdraw their request for approval of a transfer of control of any domestic Section 214 authority. Accordingly, any reference in the Application to a transfer of control of domestic Section 214 authority should be considered withdrawn and void.
