EXHIBIT — IDENTIFICATION OF ALIEN OWNERSHIP

(Response to FCC Form 312, Main Form, Question 34)

The Applicant, Orbital Compute Inc. (“Orbital”), is a Delaware corporation with its principal place of business at 525 S Santa Fe Ave, Los Angeles, CA 90013. Because the answer to Question 32 of FCC Form 312 is “Yes,” Orbital provides below the identification of the alien(s) and/or foreign entit(ies) holding capital stock of the Applicant, together with their nationality, relationship to the Applicant, and the percentage of capital stock owned of record and/or voted, as required by Question 34.

Mr. Poon, a citizen of Canada, holds 100% of the Applicant’s issued and outstanding common stock (its only class of voting stock) and serves as the Applicant’s sole officer and director. His holding alone exceeds one-fifth of the Applicant’s capital stock, which is the basis for the “Yes” response to Question 32.

For the avoidance of doubt, the Applicant seeks authority as a non-common-carrier space station licensee. The foreign-ownership limitations of Section 310(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 310(b), apply to broadcast, common-carrier, and aeronautical radio licensees and do not apply to non-common-carrier Part 25 satellite operations of the kind proposed here. This disclosure is nonetheless provided in full in response to Question 34.
