Intelsat License LLC (“Intelsat”) respectfully requests 30 days of Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) commencing upon grant but not later than September 1, 2026, to use its Nuevo, CA earth station, E060384, to provide telemetry, tracking and command (“TT&C”) services to support the post-mission disposal of the DIRECTV D9S (“D9S”) satellite.¹ For the reasons stated in DIRECTV’s application, expedited grant of STA to support the safe post-mission disposal of D9S is in the public interest.

The proposed TT&C operations will be in the following frequencies:

- 14.003 GHz and 14.497 GHz (Earth-to-space)
- 12.6955 GHz and 12.6965 GHz (space-to-Earth)

For the proposed operations, the maximum EIRP will be 85.8 dBW and maximum EIRP density will be 63.07 dBW/4 kHz.
